ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Boston Convention and Exhibition Center Kitchen Trench Drain Replacement and Floor Coating

The Massachusetts Convention Center Authority (the "Authority") will receive sealed bids for the Boston Convention and Exhibition Center Kitchen Trench Drain Replacement and Floor Coating Contract at the offices of the Authority at 415 Summer Street, Boston, Massachusetts 02210, until 12:00 noon local time on September 1, 2010, immediately after which, in a designated room, the bids will be opened and read publicly.

This contract includes providing all labor, materials and equipment necessary for the trench drain replacement and floor coating mockup at the Boston Convention and Exhibition Center.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 24, 2010 at the offices of the Authority at 415 Summer Street, Boston, Massachusetts. Bidders will have an opportunity to visit the site of the work after the pre-bid conference.

Questions or requests for information, clarification or interpretation of the bidding documents must be submitted in writing in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders and must be received no later than 5 p.m., August 25, 2010.

Contract documents for bidders will be available on or after August 11, 2010, from the Authority at the Administrative Office, 415 Summer Street, Boston, Massachusetts. The documents may be examined free of charge at the foregoing address, and each bidder may obtain one set of the documents at such address, together with any addenda or amendments which the Authority may issue. Additional sets of the documents will be available at the cost of reproduction.

Each bid shall be submitted and will be considered in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders and other Contract Documents, and shall be accompanied by a bid deposit in the amount of 5% of the value of the bid.

The Authority reserves the right to waive any informality in or to reject any or all bids if it be in the public interest to do so. The Authority reserves the right to cancel this procurement at any time without liability to any bidder or other party.

The successful general bidder will be required to furnish a performance bond and also a labor and materials or payment bond as set forth in the bid form. Attention is called to the minimum rates of wages to be paid on the work as determined under the provisions of Chapter 149, Massachusetts General Laws, Sections 26 to 27D, inclusive, as amended, and as set forth in the Contract Documents, which the contractor will be required to pay.
